We look forward to seeing you at a joint session of our Homeland Security Task Force (HSTF) and Risk Management Working Group (RMWG) on Wednesday, June 10 in Salon 1 – 4 at the Park Hyatt Hotel, 1201 24th Street, NW, Washington, DC. The meeting runs from 8:30 AM - 12:00 PM, followed by lunch.

This meeting will focus on the current threat picture and updating the Task Force on recent strategies to address these evolving threats and manage risk.

We are pleased to be joined by Intelligence Analysts from the FBI's Counterterrorism Division, Cyber Division and the Washington Field Office to discuss threats from Iran and its proxies; international terrorism threats and cyber and espionage threats to commercial facilities.

To discuss the risk management challenges for real estate in today's market, we are pleased to be joined by Duncan Ellis, Industry Practice Leader for Marsh's U.S. and Canada Real Estate & Hospitality focus. Roundtable Senior Vice President Chip Rodgers will also provide an update on the reauthorization of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, scheduled to sunset on December 31, 2027.

With funding restored, CISA and DHS are refocusing their critical infrastructure approach, prioritizing cyber incident reporting, physical security, and operational continuity. The Commercial Facilities Sector spans eight subsectors—including entertainment, retail, lodging, and sports leagues—and requires adherence to updated threat mitigation guidelines. We are pleased to be joined by Michael Stewart (Stakeholder Engagement Division, Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency) for an update. With the security challenges posed by World Cup events, we are also pleased to be joined by Casey Marquez (Office of Intelligence and Analysis, DHS) for a briefing on lone offender threats associated with the World Cup.

Enclosed please find an agenda for the meeting. As always, these discussions are closed to the press and off-the-record, so we hope to engage each of you in a series of dynamic roundtable discussion on these and other relevant homeland security issues.
