

Sustainability Policy Advisory Committee (SPAC) – Special Session EPA ENERGY STAR Workshop Wednesday, January 24, 2024 1:30 – 5:00 PM

Please join EPA's ENERGY STAR staff for an opportunity to provide input on major enhancements to Portfolio Manager that are planned for 2024 and beyond.

The Real Estate Roundtable's SPAC will hold its meeting with climate and energy policy leaders on Wednesday, January 24 from 8:30 AM — Noon. Following an informal lunch, a SPAC "special session" with EPA ENERGY STAR staff will take place from 1:30 — 5:00 PM.

The ENERGY STAR team is embarking on the first major upgrade to Portfolio Manager in a decade, supported by funding from *the Inflation Reduction Act* of 2022 to advance the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions from commercial and residential buildings. During this workshop-style session, open to members of the Real Estate Roundtable SPAC, EPA will share the latest vision for a number of major updates/enhancements to Portfolio Manager, with an emphasis on those that will most directly impact building owners.

Participants will have the chance to provide direct feedback on specific enhancements under consideration, as well as identify other items for consideration as part of the broader Portfolio Manager Upgrade effort. This session will be an excellent opportunity for SPAC members to provide detailed feedback to EPA to guide work on the upgrade. We hope you're able to participate in the ENERGY STAR Workshop.
